Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the application, File No. BPED-1816, of Back Porch Radio Broadcasting, Inc., for a construction permit for a new noncommercial educational FM broadcast station in Madison to be operated on channel 209 with an effective radiated power of 8.541 kilowatts at an antenna height above average terrain of 149 feet; and the application, File No. BPED-1843, of the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System to change the facilities of station WUWM so as to operate with an effective radiated power of 1.5 kilowatts at an antenna height above average terrain of 871 feet on channel 209.

The proposed operation of the Madison station will cause some objectionable interference within the proposed 1 millivolt-per-meter contour of the proposed Milwaukee operation. Accordingly, it appears that it may be necessary to designate the two applications for hearing to determine which, if either, should be granted.

Should an amendment be submitted to resolve the interference conflict, the amendment should be submitted in triplicate and signed in the same manner as was the original application. Furthermore, should such an amendment be

submitted, it should be accompanied by an affidavit as to whether or not consideration has been promised to or received, directly or indirectly, in connection with the amendment (see section 1.525(e)(1) of the Commission's rules).
